

# Minutes of the meeting of the Finance Monitoring Committee held in the Council Chamber, Whitworth Civic Hall on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at 7pm.

### 1. To receive apologies.

Apologies were received from Cllr Burton and Cllr Greenwood who were unwell and Cllr Ritson kindly agreed to substitute.

### 2. To consider the minutes of the meeting held on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2025, and to approve them by the signature of the Chairman as a correct record.

<u>It was resolved that</u> the minutes of the meeting held on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> November 2025, copies of which had been circulated to each member, were correct and should be approved by the signature of the Chairman as a correct record. This was moved by Councillor Neal and seconded by Councillor Chorlton.

## 3. To consider budget versions 4b and 4c for 2026-2027 and receive suggestions from members for projects to consider for the next financial year.

Councillors discussed Local Government Reorganisation and elections, and the budget versions 4b and 4c for 2026-2027. Councillors suggested

- To postpone the provision for 7.5 hours a week for a gardener at National Living wage.
- Amendments were suggested to increase the provision for Christmas Lights, benches for the MUGA and Parliament Week.
- Keep 60 hours of office work per week.

This resulted in a proposed precept of £88,913, £35.48 per Band D equivalent using the 25/26 council tax base, which is an increase of £1.63 or 4.8%. Rossendale Borough Council have been contacted regarding the 26/27 council tax base, and this will be amended once the figures are available.

### 4. Any other business.

Councillors requested that the Local Government Reorganisation working group feedback in the next Finance Monitoring Committee meeting.

### 5. To set the date for the next meeting

The next meeting will be arranged in the New Year.
