# WHITWORTH BAND INVESTS IN THE FUTURE WITH ITS VERY OWN BAND ACADEMY

Whitworth Vale and Healey Band has run a successful youth programme for years, with many youth band players going on to play in the senior band. Now this commitment has gone one step further with the formation of the Whitworth Band Academy, providing Whitworth primary school children with the opportunity to learn to play a brass instrument, supported by members of the Whitworth Band organisation. At the end of ten weeks the Youth Band plays alongside the Band Academy students in a concert for parents and friends. The first school to benefit was St Bartholomew's CE Primary, where the academy was hugely successful, and in September the academy moved to Our Lady and St Anselm's RC Primary.

This considerable investment into Whitworth's young people has been part funded by donations the band received in memory of former Whitworth Vale and Healey Band president, Jimmy Grogan. Jimmy - Honorary Townsman and former Mayor of Rossendale and Whitworth and a band champion - had a real passion for the youth band's development. The Academy is run by Aaron Wolfe and Owen Garbutt, both graduates of Salford University that grew up in Whitworth and benefited from playing in the Youth and Senior Bands. They are keen to help the band to develop similar opportunities for today's schoolchildren.

#### **ROUTES AROUND ROSSENDALE**

The 'Routes around Rossendale' project was developed and managed by Proffitts in Spring 2014.

The project provides a series of way marked circular loop paths to explore the Rossendale Valley from Waterfoot to Shawforth. The loop paths are designed for beginner to intermediate walkers and range from urban roads to the country tracks of the Pennine Bridleway and Mary Towneley Loop. All loop paths start and end at a main car park and always bring users back to the main arterial road that cuts through the heart of the valley. The project, funded by Natural England's Paths For Communities scheme and by Lancashire Environmental Fund, has also ensured a new 1km section of off road multi user path (running from Blackwood Road to Rakehead Lane in Stacksteads) has been implemented - providing yet another piece of the ambitious Valley of Stone Greenway (off-road multi user routes from Rochdale to Rawtenstall). This new route forms part of Loop 5 in the walk leaflet. The leaflets are available from tourist spots locally around Rossendale or online at:





# WHITWORTH HISTORICAL SOCIETY & MUSEUM: PRIVATE ROLAND FARROW

As a young man, Roland Farrow was employed as a joiner and lived with his parents at 3 Princess Street, Whitworth, but just two days after his nineteenth birthday on 10 December 1915 he enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers. Following military training, Roland found himself travelling to France and the battlefields of the Western Front. During the Battle of the Somme (1 July - 18 November 1916) Roland suffered the loss of his left leg and hip and underwent several field operations before being transferred back to 'Blighty' and into the Edmonton Military Hospital. Fortunately by that stage prosthetics were reasonably well developed and Roland was fitted with an artificial limb at the Queen Mary Convalescent Auxiliary Hospital, Roehampton. After a long convalescence period. Roland was discharged from military service on 10 January 1918. Unable to return to his former trade. Roland opened a greengrocer's shop on Market Street, Whitworth where he was later joined by his wife Evelyn and eventually by their son Geoffrey. A pair of crutches, originally issued to Roland in France following his injuries in 1916, are on display at

the Whitworth Museum. Whitworth Museum on North Street is open to visitors throughout the year on Saturdays 2pm - 4pm and on Tuesday evenings 7.30pm - 9.30pm; other times by appointment.


