SPODDEN VALLEY REVEALED AWARDED NATIONAL LOTTERY SUPPORT

Mid Pennine Arts (MPA) has received a confirmed grant (£246,500) from the Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) for Spodden Valley Revealed (SVR). Thanks to money raised by National Lottery players, the project aims to create a 'greenway ecomuseum', a linear heritage destination exploring the long and unique history of human settlement in the area around Whitworth in Lancashire. The stories SVR will explore include stone age hunting sites and the relics left behind, and individual characters such as James 'Treacle' Sanderson running close to the sub 4-minute mile 90 years before Roger Bannister, and the Whitworth Doctors – 18th century 'bone setters' attracting patients from all over the UK such as the Archbishop of Canterbury with curious and strange treatments.



SVR will be made up of a 'string of pearls' of historic sites, which visitors will be encouraged to discover by signposting on a central cycling and walking route, interpretation, public art pieces and community events.

The Mayor of Whitworth, Councillor Alan Neal said: "We are really excited to be involved with Spodden Valley Revealed in Whitworth and can't wait to get all the local schools and groups involved in creating something which will benefit the whole community. It will be a great advantage for tourism in Whitworth and will provide more leisure facilities for local people."

MPA are also delighted to announce support for SVR from the Lancashire Environmental Fund and charity Newground Together. Their awards of £25,000 and £35,000 respectively helped to secure the funding from HLF. The project will also receive support from Lancashire County Council and Whitworth Town Council.



The role of the Community Beat Manager (CBM) has now changed to that of a local 'Hybrid Officer' with this role being required to provide a dual focus of both responding to calls across Rossendale; while also having a local policing function similar to that previously undertaken by the CBM. The officer recently appointed to this role for Whitworth is PC Lisa Hodgkinson who has already been working with Heidi on issues specific to Whitworth. In the near future it is planned for a further officer to assist Heidi and Lisa through undertaking a Hybrid role aligned to Whitworth and we will keep you updated on how this develops.

Reports of crime across Lancashire have increased by 15% and in Rossendale have increased by 5.5%. Despite a recent spate of damage caused to vehicles around Healey, crime continues to be very low with on average 1 to 2 crimes reported per day in Whitworth. In relation to this recent damage, Heidi and other local officers conducted letter drops in the area and published a press release encouraging victims to report damage and to appeal for witnesses. 


